Coming from I5 North-go south on I5 and take the Barnett Rd Exit stay to the left at the top of offramp, turn left onto Highland Drive, then go right on Barnett, right on Black Oak Drive. St Mary's School is on the left, not too far down, field is in back.

Going North on I5, take the Barnett Rd Exit and take right on Barnett, right on Black Oak Dr. St. Mary's School is on the left, field is in back.

ENTRIES & CLOSING DATE: Your entry must be RECEIVED by September 1, 2023, to be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees made payable to **RCA** You must file a separate entry form for each dog entered (i.e., only one dog per form).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required by the first day of the Trial.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$25.00 for returned checks.
- In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be always on leash except when using the warm-up area or in the agility ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the current edition of TDAA's Rules and Regulations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the Trial.
- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the hotel and at the Trial Site.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignias of their training group, if they wish.
- Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are PROHIBITED.

NEW RULES REGARDING USE OF FOOD IN THE RING As of January 1, 2019, TDAA has issued new rules regarding the use of food in the ring: 5.2.2.11 Use of Food Treats The handler shall be allowed to carry and use food treats in the ring as reward for the dog so long as the food treat is not offered in a way that assists the dog in course direction or in the performance of an obstacle. The dog is faulted when the handler uses a food treat in a manner that assists the dog in course direction (standard fault) or in the performance of an obstacle (failure to perform). A food treat must be kept secure by the handler. The dog shall earn a standard fault if the handler carries food in hand while the dog is working or at any time drops a food treat on the floor or equipment. Questions regarding this rule change will be addressed during the General Briefing each day of the trial.

Obstacle Familiarization - obstacle familiarization will be held Saturday and Sunday morning 30 minutes prior to judging for dogs.

Warm-ups - a warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all Exhibitors.

Eligibility - this trial is open to all dogs **20-inches** and under at the withers that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Move-Ups - Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move-up requests must be in writing but may be sent via e-mail. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the Move-Up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned. "Move-up Request Form" is set out later in premium and available on the Secretary's Table at show.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. FEO (For Exhibition Only) will be offered.

CLASS INFORMATION

Games Classes

Games I - All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Games II - Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III - Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Power & Speed: a numbered course that is split between the power section and the speed section. The power Section is composed of contact obstacles, weave poles, and tunnels. The speed section is composed of jumps and tunnels and is timed with faults added to the time.

Mute Agility: a standard course that is run silent. No verbal commands are allowed, no clapping, no stomping which will be faulted.

Full House: a dogs choice game where you collect the elements of a full house and required points for your level.

Blackhole – The Black Hole course is designed to suggest a logical path to the dog that presents on-course tunnels as inviting opportunities. Time stops when the dog goes into a tunnel.

Snooker – Snooker is a two-part game. Each part is played and scored on a different basis. The opening sequence the handler will perform a "red" jump and a different obstacle for specified number of points. After the opening sequence, the handler should direct the dog through the numbered course for points.

For more information on these games the **Book of Agility Games** is available; please visit: k9tdaa.com. Judges reserve the right to adapt any game played. Day of show rules supersede all others.

Be sure to check your records and let me know if you are close to earning a Championship of any type. We want to make sure we have enough ribbons so that we can celebrate with you.

Jump Height Divisions:

TDAA offers the following Jump Height Divisions: 2", 4", 8", 12", 16". Owners/handlers are responsible for entering their dog at the proper height division, both the dog's measured jump height and the height at which they want their dog to jump at the trial. Per TDAA rules, dogs may be entered at any jump height desired; however, the scoring height continues to be the dog's measured jump height. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. The judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. Any dog that has not previously competed at a TDAA trial must be measured before competing.

Jump Height Exemptions (only applicable for National or Regional Competitions):

In national or regional competitions, such as the Petit Prix, dogs are required to jump at their measured height, as adjusted for any jump height exemptions to which they are entitled. Jump height exemptions are provided for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see k9tdaa.com, TDAA Rules and Regulations, Sec. 3.5.3 for descriptions of jump height exemptions). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs at least 7 years of age) and a second exemption (two jump heights) will be granted to "double digit" veterans (dogs at least 10 years of age). You may subtract one height for veteran status, one for double digit veteran status, and one for body exemption from Measured Jump Height.

Disabled Handlers: A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course times for Games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial.

Entries

Entries close September 1, 2023, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. Day of Event Entries **WILL BE** accepted **up to 7:30** each morning, for an additional \$2.00 per run. TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official Entry forms. One dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries, without the signed TDAA Agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned check(s). Subsequent returned check(s) from the same Exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
